NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Protection is moderate in municipal worksites, restaurants, and bars in restaurants with designated smoking areas allowed if separately ventilated. Protection is limited in municipal worksites, with designated smoking areas allowed or required. No protection is provided in bars not in restaurants. Fines up to \$500 exist for violations by businesses and smokers. The mayor's or city council's designee is the enforcer.
