# **NARRATIVE SUMMARY**

Smoking is prohibited (100% smoke free) in municipal worksites. Protection is partial in restaurants due to exceptions, ambiguities, or legal issues. No protection is provided in private worksites, bars in restaurants, and bars not in restaurants. Fines up to \$2,000 and other penalties exist for violations by businesses and smokers. Law officers, Fire officials, Health officers, Business representatives, and Private Individuals are enforcers.
