NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Smoking is prohibited (100% smoke free) in municipal worksites, restaurants, and bars in restaurants. Protection is mixed in private worksites with exceptions, ambiguities or legal issues. No protection is provided in bars not in restaurants. Fines up to \$50 exist for violations by smokers. Fines up to \$500 and other penalties exist for violations by businesses. Law officers, Health officers, Other city officials, Business representatives, and Private Individuals are enforcers.
